Each Master program is assigned to a specific campus.



The dual degree is organized as follows:

- Students enrolled on the GT Atlanta or GT Lorraine campus are eligible to apply to this program. You may spend the Fall/Spring semesters either on the GT Atlanta campus or GT Lorraine campus.
- On a case by case basis, you may intern in industry (depending on available opportunities and profiles) over the Summer semester.
- In the following Fall and Spring terms, you may join the Arts et Metiers campus to complete your Master's degree, and transfer two of those courses to GT to complete your MSME requirement. The European Master's degree courses are offered in English or in French.
