DUPL CRSE WITH SEC-XXXXX

Error Explanation:

If you are trying to take 2 courses with the same subject code and course number, you will get an error. OSCAR will only allow students to have one subject/course in their schedule. OSCAR looks at subject code (i.e. MATH, ENGL, etc.) and course number (2501, 1502, etc.), but not the section number.

Special topics often have the same course number, with different section numbers. The ME department offers several special topics classes, each with the same number. This is the reason why different classes have the same subject codes and course numbers.

Solution:

- If you are trying to change your section, you must drop your original section and add the new section. Example: If you have Math 1501 A in your schedule, you cannot change your section to Math 1501 B until you drop Math 1501 A.
- If you are trying to take two different classes which have the same number (ex. ME 4803 A and ME 4803 B), you must request a duplicate course permit override from the department offering the courses.
